WHAT FISH CAN I FIND AT HARD LABOR CREEK REGIONAL RESERVOIR?

LARGEMOUTH BASS



- Upper jaw extends beyond eye
- Spiny/soft dorsal fin separate or nearly so
- Tongue normally smooth, tooth patch rare

BLUEGILL



- Black spot on soft dorsal fin
- Vertical bars on body

REDEAR SUNFISH



- Red edge on operculum ear flap
- Spotted body

BLACK CRAPPIE



- 7-8 dorsal spines
- Body pattern irregularly arranged

CHANNEL CATFISH



- Numerous small, black spots present
- Deeply forked tail fin

THREADFIN SHAD



- Mouth at end of pointed snout
- Elongated dorsal fin ray
- Yellow tail fin
